## ***Breakfast and Lunch ANNOUNCEMENT!***

Cromwell-Wright School is qualified to participate in the USDA's FREE MEAL PROGRAM for all students for the Fall of 2020.

### What does this mean?

- The USDA announced that they would provide free meals for all students with money designated for the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) from Congress.
- **This money will not span the entire school year**, but they feel confident that they can provide funding for part, if not all, of the remainder of 2020.
- Initial reports from the August 31, 2020 announcement indicated that meals would be free through December 31, 2020. After further analysis it is evident that the funds may not last that long.

### How does this affect families at Cromwell-Wright School?

- **All students will eat breakfast and lunch free of charge** until the funds are exhausted. This could be at any point between NOW and December 31, 2020.
  - The district will notify you when meal charges resume.
- All families should submit a Free and Reduced lunch application ASAP. We cannot back pay any amounts accumulated prior to your application.
  - **Applications are also used for calculating other sources of Aid for the district. It is important that they are submitted as soon as possible.** They are confidential and we encourage all families to submit one.
- Money previously submitted to lunch accounts will stay in the accounts for future use. At the latest point, January 1, 2021 is when meal charges will start accruing again.
  - If you submitted lunch money and are approved for Free or Reduced prices for the 2020-21 School Year, we can submit a reimbursement request to the district office.

### What about MILK?

- If your student brings a lunch from home and gets milk at school, the \$0.50 charge will still be applicable. Unfortunately, the program only covers full meals, this is out of our control.

### Where do I find a menu?

- The homepage of the school website now has a "LUNCH MENU" category.
- Due to the uncertainty of the year, and availability of certain products, menu planning for more than a week or two at a time has proven to be challenging. Please view the website for the most up to date menu information.
