SERVICES AVAILABLE DURING THE COVID-19 CLOSURE TO CROMWELL-WRIGHT PUBLIC SCHOOL FAMILIES:

This rapidly changing emergency situation has forced us to develop plans as a district to properly care for the children that would normally be in our buildings. We are making valiant efforts to organize plans and create a stream of information that is available to all of our families. Please take note of the following services being offered by our District and do not hesitate to contact us if you haven't already. We must work together during these uncertain times and ensure everyone is taken care of. Please consider taking advantage of these great services we will have in the coming days.

MEAL SERVICE FOR ALL FAMILIES:

Automated phone calls were sent on Monday, March 16, 2020 to inform families of the availability of this service. Follow up calls were made to families on Tuesday, March 17, 2020 to solicit the service and give specific details. **Families may elect to this service at any time** during the closure period. Contact the school office to be added to the list. Staff will be on hand to prepare and distribute meals to any families that may be in need. This includes ALL families regardless of meal status.

- Meals will be available this Wednesday 3/18- Friday 3/20 by curbside delivery. Someone in your family should come to the front of the school between 11:00am-12:00pm to pick up meals for the day. Meals will be brought out to the car.
- A consent form will be issued at this time that gives the district permission to deliver meals to your home in the future.
- There will be no meals available on Monday, March 23, 2020. This was a regularly scheduled day off for students.
- Our goal is to have a delivery service implemented for meals by Tuesday, March 24, 2020.

- Further communications will be distributed as details are finalized.
- If curbside pickup is not an option for your family at this time and you need to receive the meals, please contact us ASAP.

CHILDCARE FOR HEALTHCARE AND EMERGENCY PERSONNEL

Automated calls were also sent on Monday, March 16, 2020 to notify parents of this service. Staff will be available during day time hours to provide care to families that work in healthcare and emergency personnel full time. Families may elect to this service at any time. We ask for a day prior notice in order to ensure we are fully staffed. Contact the school office to be added to the list.

As this situation continues to change we will do our best to keep our families up to date as possible. The following outlines information known at this time.

- Students were directed to take all personal belongings with them today.
- The school is CLOSED to the public as of Wednesday, March 18, 2020
- The GYMS and WEIGHT ROOM are CLOSED.
- Teachers will be on duty over the next 8 days to implement elearning and distance learning plans. More information will be communicated as it is known.
- As the situation continues to change we will keep families up to date via website and automated alerts via phone and/or email.
- Please be aware that this is a serious situation. This could affect families for weeks to come, do not hesitate to reach out to the district as needs arise.
- Please encourage High School students to follow recommendations regarding social distancing and gathering, and follow proper hygiene practices.
- Be aware of services we are offering to ease this situation. Meal service and childcare information for healthcare and emergency workers has been communicated.
- Elementary Conferences will still be held via PHONE on March 25 & 26 from 3:30-6:00 pm. Please see the school website to sign up for a time with your student's ELEMENTARY teacher. Teachers will call you, please update your contact info. ASAP.
- High School Conferences will also be held via PHONE or EMAIL. Please contact your student's teachers during the allotted conference time on March 25 & 26 from 3:30-6:00pm or email them with a time best to reach you.
